Complete Sentences

End with period/exclamation point/question mark

Start with a capital letter

Subject (Actor)

Verb (Action)

Jane went to the store.

S V

Run-Ons

A run-on is the result of connecting sentences with a comma or connecting sentences with no mark of punctuation.

Example This weekend's weather forecast is very cold, it is likely to snow.

you see in this example the punctuation is wrong place or not suppose to be there.

Fragments

A fragment is simply an incomplete sentence - it does not have all the parts required to be a complete sentence.

Example: Through the forest.

You See that it has nothing that makes it a true complete sentence
