# What is a quote sandwich?

# What is needed in a quote sandwich?

# Steps in a quote sandwich(step 1)

## Step 1

# Steps in a quote sandwich(step 2)

- Ex. According to Joseph Stalin “Education is a weapon whose effects depend on who holds it in his hands and at whom it is aimed.”

# Steps in a quote sandwich(step 3)

## Step 3

Analyze your quote

- This is where you back up the quote with your own words/ideas.
- Ex. According to Stephen Hawking “Intelligence is the ability to adapt to change.” What Stephen Hawking is saying is that if you lack the ability to adapt to change, you do not have intelligence.

# Conclusion of quote sandwiches
